## Lifetime Recovery Awarded \$1,000,000 Challenge Grant from the J.E. & L.E. Mabee Foundation

San Antonio, TX - Lifetime Recovery is excited to announce significant strides in our Building for Recovery Phase III campaign. Lifetime has just been awarded a \$1,000,000 challenge grant from the J.E. & L.E. Mabee Foundation to renovate and expand our facilities to meet the growing client need and to expand residential substance use disorder treatment to women. To receive funds from the foundation, all challenge dollars must be raised by July 2024.

Phase Three of our Building for Recovery \$5 million campaign will consist of the renovation of the primary building, "Old Main" which will be renamed the "Red McCombs Recovery Center." Renovations will upgrade two residential halls providing over 60 client beds, additional open group spaces, counseling offices, an upgraded auditorium, and a family & community center, all designed to offer each person the dignity of healthy surroundings that are more conducive to evidence-based treatment.

Lifetime now needs to raise the remaining \$1.9 million to reach our fundraising goal. This challenge grant will have a direct impact and will ensure the successful completion of our building campaign."
