Lifetime Recovery's restoration of "Old Main," a grand example of Spanish Colonial Revival architecture will provide a classic, serene environment for chemical dependency treatment for thousands of people. The 1930s building at the center of the campus will be enhanced by 21st century infrastructure and amenities, a new environment for healing and recovery.



THE RED McCOMBS RECOVERY CENTER AT THE SOUTHTON CAMPUS

The primary building, "Old Main" or as it will be now be named the "Red McCombs Recovery Center" will be remodeled to provide residential care in a dormitory setting.

Phase Two of our Building for Recovery campaign will consist of the renovation of two residential dormitories, adding several semi-private suites. Additional projects include the remodeling of counseling offices and group rooms.

Thanks to the generosity of community partners and donors, funding for Phase One, \$4.5 million, has been secured. Phase One of construction began in October 2020 and is expected to be completed by June 2021.

Lifetime is currently focused on reaching our next milestone of raising \$3.2 million for Phase Two of our Building for Recovery campaign by mid-2021.


New community spaces and reimagined counseling office for individual and small group work are conducive to evidence-based treatment.

Lifetime Recovery is the largest non-profit residential substance abuse treatment facility in Bexar and surrounding counties. Renovations will give Lifetime the ability to expand community and group counseling while enhancing the two existing residential dormitories that are in desperate need of remodeling.

Renovations will provide over 60 client beds, additional open group spaces and an upgraded auditorium.




Floor Plan of two Dormitories
